Caldwell Roberson Sr. was born March 1, 1937 to Charlie and Narcissus (Carter) Roberson but was raised by his grandmother Nellie Carter, because at an early age he didn't like Mississippi. So Grand Bay and Dawes became his home. He accepted Christ at an early age at Providence Missionary Baptist Church where he'd become a long-time member until his health declined.

Caldwell attended Dawes Union Elementary School, Magnolia High School, and St. Elmo High School where he graduated in 1958. In 1962, he married Barbara Jean Young Roberson and they went on to have 5 children, Dwayne, Caldwell Jr, Robert, Cynthia, and Tyrone.

In those years Caldwell went on to work numerous jobs, but it wasn't until 1972 he found his calling at Thikol/Morton International in Moss Point, MS where he worked for 26 years until his retirement in 1998. After his retirement in 1998, Caldwell couldn't sit still. He then went to work for Mobile Museum of Arts in Mobile, AL until 2002.

Caldwell was preceded in death by his father, Charlie, mother, Narcissus, two sisters Christine and Dorothy, and half brother Willie Earl. He is survived by his loving wife of 58 years Barbara, his five wonderful children, Dwayne (Rita) Roberson, Caldwell Jr (Quinetta) Roberson, Robert Roberson, Cynthia (Levice) Washington, and Tyrone (Markinia) Roberson.
