Clayton Alfred Reeves, age 90, beloved father, brother, grandfather, great-grandfather, uncle and faithful child of God, passed away peacefully in his home in Mobile, AL on May 31, 2020. He was born on February 23, 1930 in Laurel Hill, Florida to Obie and Lola Reeves.

He enlisted in the United States Army in 1951 and served his country honorably in Korea.
